Applicant Details	No points awarded	Project must list the name of at least one other teacher for consideration.
Project Overview 12 total points	Summary - Up to 4 points may be awarded	Scale: 0 = Fails to answer. 1 = Provides a basic summary of the project, but does not address how it engages students, or the expected outcomes. 2 = Provides a basic summary of the project, how it engages students and the expected outcomes. 3 = Provides a detailed summary of the project, how it engages students, and the expected outcomes. The summary peaks the interest of the reader. 4 = Provides an exceptional summary of the project, how it engages students, and the expected outcomes. The summary leaves the reader with a full understanding of the project and excitement for its implementation.
	Project activities and alignment with the curriculum - Up to 4 points may be awarded	Scale: 0 = Fails to answer. 1 = Describes the project activities or alignment to the curriculum, but not both. 2 = Provides a basic overview of activities, and gives a basic description of how activities align with the curriculum. 3 = Provides the reader a good understanding of the project activities, how they will be carried out and how the project aligns with the curriculum. 4 = Provides the reader a clear and full understanding of how the project will be carried out and how it aligns with the curriculum. Note: Grant Readers are not responsible for determining the curriculum. Grant Readers should rely on what the application states the curriculum to be.
	Goals and outcomes - Up to 2 points may be awarded	Scale: 0 = The goals and expected outcomes are not clear. 1 = The goals and expected outcomes are clear. 2 = The goals and expected outcomes are clear and impactful.

	Materials - Up to 2 points may be awarded	Scale: 0 = Answer is not clear about what new or existing materials are required or how they will be used. 1 = Answer provides basic information on what new or existing materials are required or how they will be used. 2 = Answer provides detailed information on what new or existing materials are required or how they will be used.
Project Impact 6 total points	Engaging students and enhancing growth - Up to 4 points may be awarded	Scale: 0 = Fails to answer. 1 = Answer is not clear on how the project will engage students or how the project will enhance student growth. 2 = Answer provides basic information on how students are engaged and how the project enhances growth. 3 = Answer provides detailed information on how students are engaged and how the project enhances growth. 4 = Answer provides exceptional information on how students are engaged and how the project enhances growth in a clear way.
	Replicating the project - Up to 2 points may be awarded	Scale: 0 = The project cannot be replicated or shared into other classrooms or buildings. 1 = There is some evidence that this project could be replicated in other classrooms 2 = This project is easily replicated or shared in other classrooms and across the district.
Project Evaluation 2 points	Assessing learning and outcomes - Up to 2 points may be awarded	Scale: 0 = Answer is not clear on how learning and outcomes will be assessed. 1 = Answer provides a basic understanding of how learning and outcomes will be assessed. 2 = Answer provides detailed information on how learning and outcomes are assessed.
Budget	No points awarded	Budget will be noted as "present" or "not present". The budget must be detailed in order to be considered for an award. Projects without a budget will not be considered.
Promotion of Grant	No points awarded	All applicants must agree to promote awarded grants as described on the application.
Compliance with Guidelines	No points awarded	All applicants are expected to comply with guidelines as described on the application.
